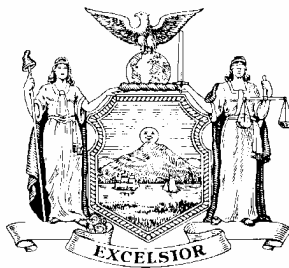

OVERVIEW

The Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) FFY 2010 Intended Use Plan (IUP) is being amended to reflect the policies and procedures for the administration of portions of New York State's FFY 2010 CWSRF appropriation to be used for additional subsidization and Green Project Reserve funding. This IUP Amendment presents the criteria for selection of projects to receive these funds, as well as the conditions recipients of these funds will be required to meet.

In addition, the amendment reflects the availability of an additional \$15 million in resources from the FFY 2009 IUP along with \$25 million in capital released from long term investments back to the CWSRF, adjustments to available CWSRF funds, and projects that may be financed during the FFY 2010 IUP financing period. These adjustments include by-passing and cost changes to projects on the final 2010 CWSRF IUP Annual Project Priority Lists (PPL), three projects that were inadvertently omitted from the final IUP Annual List due to administrative oversight, two projects to cover costs that pre-dated the implementation of ARRA that had been included in ARRA projects, the addition of 6 projects associated with 1998 and 1999 leveraged financing that are being included as part of a bond refunding, and nine projects switching from Category A to B on the Annual list based on population figures.

The amendment further clarifies the requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act as it applies to CWSRF financings in FFY 2010, establishes submission dates for applications for CWSRF financial assistance for the remainder of the 2010 IUP period, and announces the launching of a Long Term Market Rate Financing Program.

ADDITIONAL SUBSIDIZATION

As part of the FFY 2010 CWSRF appropriation, Congress mandated that at least 30% of the appropriated CWSRF funds in excess of \$1 billion be made available as additional subsidization for eligible projects. The NYS Environmental Facilities Corporation (EFC) and the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) propose to provide 100% of New York State's portion of such funds, a total of \$112,275,279, as additional subsidization.

IUP Section 1.3 Program Issues and Initiatives

The bullet in this section for Pre-Design Planning Grants should reference Section 2.2.3 of the IUP, not Section 2.2.4

IUP Section 2.1.4 - GREEN PROJECT RESERVE

Section 2.1.4 in the Final CWSRF 2010 IUP is replaced with the following:

As part of the FFY 2010 CWSRF appropriation, Congress mandated that 20% of the appropriated CWSRF funds be made available for projects, or certain aspects of projects, that meet the criteria of

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Green Project Reserve (GPR). To be considered as GPR, projects will need to be CWSRF eligible, and will have aspects that are intended to address stormwater and wet weather issues through the use of green infrastructure, promote energy efficiency, water efficiency, or utilize innovative approaches to managing water resources. Draft guidance has been issued from EPA as part of their March 24, 2010 Draft 2010 SRF Procedures memo .

For New York State, the minimum amount of the FFY 2010 CWSRF appropriation that must meet the requirements of GPR is \$44,979,600. A portion of the GPR in the amount of \$15,000,000 will be available in Category G and offered through a new round of the Green Innovation Grant Program (GIGP). In addition, \$30,000,000 will be available in Category C, and the New York Water Municipal Water Finance Authority (NYCMWFA) has agreed to focus these funds towards projects that qualify under GPR.

Additional information about New York's CWSRF GPR and green innovation, including examples of CWSRF capital project GPR eligibility, will be available on EFC's web site at www.nysefc.org. There are expected to be sufficient projects in Categories A, B, C, D, and G on the 2010 Annual IUP to fulfill the GPR obligation. The final projects identified as candidates to receive GPR funding will be presented in a subsequent IUP amendment.

Green Innovation Grant Program (GIGP) – EFC will be offering a new round of GPR grant funding through the GIGP for FFY 2010. To be considered for GIGP funding, projects are not required to be listed on the CWSRF PPL. GIGP projects must meet the applicable requirements of both GPR and the CWSRF program. For projects that qualify for the GIGP, EFC will provide grants subject to availability of funds. Depending on the availability of eligible applications for projects that meet program requirements, EFC estimates that \$15,000,000 of additional subsidization will be used through the GIGP. EFC anticipates accepting GIGP applications in the summer of 2010 for projects that meet the criteria of GPR. Application procedures, forms, eligibility guidance, criteria for selection, and other GIGP program requirements are being developed.

EFC will announce the availability of the GIGP forms and guidance documents by a future notice on the EFC website, the State Register, and the Environmental Notice Bulletin. Projects deemed eligible for GIGP funding will be listed in the Category G Annual List in a subsequent IUP amendment.

IUP Section 2.2.3 Pre-Design Planning Grants

Section 2.2.3 in the Final CWSRF 2010 IUP is replaced with the following:

A significant impediment for many communities to initiate water quality projects is the cost of the engineering and planning effort to determine the scope of the water quality issues and the means of mitigating these issues. In order to facilitate planning of water quality projects, EFC will offer pre-design planning grants to municipal applicants facing economic hardship to assist in paying for planning of CWSRF-eligible water quality projects. A total of \$1 million, supported by EFC's administrative fee account, will be available for these grants in FFY 2010. EFC will announce the availability of this pre-design planning grant assistance by notice on the EFC website, the State Register, and the Environmental Notice Bulletin. Application materials and program guidelines are being developed and will be available on the EFC website (www.nysefc.org). Please visit EFC's

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website at www.nysefc.org for updates or sign up to receive e-mail notifications regarding the CWSRF and pre-design planning grants.

EFC anticipates that the scope of work for pre-design planning grants could include engineering and/or consultant fees for SEQR preparation, archeological services, planning, and pre-design engineering, such as the preparation of an engineering report. Recipients will be required to enter into an agreement to ensure proper use of the funds.

IUP Section 2.2.8 DAVIS-BACON COMPLIANCE

Section 2.2.8 in the Final CWSRF 2010 IUP is replaced with the following:

As part of the FFY 2010 budget appropriation for the CWSRF, Congress mandated that federal labor laws regarding prevailing wages, hours of work, and rates of pay shall apply to construction carried out in whole or in part with assistance from CWSRFs. These requirements are collectively known as the Davis-Bacon laws. These requirements are in addition to the requirements of NYS prevailing wage laws. Recent EPA guidance requires that any CWSRF financings made after October 30, 2009 will be required to comply with the Davis-Bacon laws and incorporate these provisions into any project work that has been or will be contracted. With the exception of projects funded by American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 funds, projects that closed an EFC financing prior to October 30, 2009 will generally not be required to incorporate Davis-Bacon requirements. Work done by a municipal applicant's employees, generally known as "force account" or "work force", is not generally subject to Davis-Bacon requirements.

IUP Section 3.1 CWSRF Financing Applications

The first paragraph of Section 3.1 in the Final CWSRF 2010 IUP is replaced with the following three paragraphs:

EFC will accept applications for CWSRF financing on a continuous basis. The availability of subsidized financing is limited; market rate financing is available for any project ready to be financed in this IUP period.

EFC's goal is to fully use available FFY 2010 funds. As a result, EFC will continuously bypass projects that will not proceed towards financing in this IUP period until we have identified sufficient projects. Through this bypass process, we will be contacting municipalities with projects below the subsidy line, in order of listing priority, to determine whether they are willing and able to proceed with their project in this IUP period. In this way, EFC will make available bypass funds to municipalities with projects listed below the subsidy line.

Municipalities with projects on the final amended 2010 IUP Annual List in Category D and above the subsidy lines in Categories A and B should submit complete CWSRF financing applications for their projects by **April 30, 2010** to be considered for subsidized CWSRF funds. Municipalities with projects on the final amended Annual List in Categories A and B below the subsidy line should submit complete CWSRF financing applications for their projects by **June 15, 2010** to be considered for guarantee or subsidized CWSRF funds should their projects become reachable

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through by-passing of projects above the subsidy line. Any complete applications submitted after June 15, 2010 will be considered for funding only after all other applications submitted have been processed, and available funds have been identified. Application forms and guidance materials are available on the EFC website (www.nysefc.org). Please call EFC at 1-800-882-9721 for guidance.

IUP Section 3.4.2 Long Term Market Rate Financing Program

The Long Term Market Rate Financing Program (LTMRP) is available to support eligible projects for which CWSRF subsidized funding is not available. Bonds issued by recipients and purchased by EFC may be issued for terms of up to thirty years from the financing date.

The LTMRP Program offers eligible recipients access to financing at preferred AAA interest rates. EFC will determine which projects can receive CWSRF subsidized or LTMRP Program funding. Applicants will be contacted regarding their financing options. For recipients who take advantage of the LTMRP Program, we will retain their project on the Annual Project Priority List so as to enable these recipients to compete in future years for a CWSRF subsidized funding or a hardship determination, if applicable

Bond Guarantee Program – this was renumbered from 3.4.2 to 3.4.3 to allow for the insertion of the new Long Term Market Rate Financing Program

NEW IUP Section 3.7 Additional Subsidization

The FFY 2010 CWSRF appropriation included authorization to provide additional subsidization, and EFC intends to offer the maximum amount (\$112,275,279) allowable. EFC intends to direct \$67,275,279 for initial project financing for projects in Disadvantaged Communities as defined below. The balance of the additional subsidization will be offered for projects that meet GPR requirements as follows; \$15,000,000 offered in Category G through the GIGP, and \$30,000,000 in Category C to the NYCMWFA.

EFC is defining an initial project financing as a new project with no additional points assigned, whether from a phased or segmented project, or for a previously closed project financing with EFC. EFC is defining a Disadvantaged Community as a municipality primarily serving a residential population where the Median Household Income (MHI) is equal to or less than the statewide MHI (\$43,393) based on the 2000 US Census.

Additional subsidization will be offered to qualifying applicants above the subsidy line or reached through bypass on the 2010 Annual IUP List in accordance with project score in Categories A, B & D until all funds are allocated. EFC will offer additional subsidization through the issuance of a commitment letter to the municipality requiring execution of a short term financing by September 30, 2011 in order for the project to remain eligible for additional subsidization. To meet this date, the municipality will be required to submit a complete application for CWSRF financing as soon as they are prepared to proceed with their financing, but no later than June 15, 2011. Projects that are offered the opportunity of additional subsidization and do not close their CWSRF financing by September 30, 2011 will continue to be eligible for CWSRF financing, subject to availability of funds. Additional subsidization will only be delivered in conjunction with the conversion of the CWSRF financing to EFC long term financing.

NEW IUP Section 3.7.1 Project Categories A and B

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Eligible projects listed above the subsidy line in the Annual CWSRF Project Priority list for Project Categories A and B may receive additional subsidization for up to 50% of eligible project costs. The total amount of additional subsidization available for Project Category A is \$ 7,179,521 . The total amount of additional subsidization available for Project Category B is \$30,095,758.

For eligible projects listed in Project Category A, the maximum additional subsidization per project is \$2 million. However, no municipality may receive more than \$2 million total in additional subsidization for any combination or series of projects. In addition, no project, if split or shared between municipalities, may receive more than \$2 million in additional subsidization.

For eligible projects listed in Project Category B, the maximum additional subsidization per project is \$4 million. However, no municipality may receive more than \$4 million total in additional subsidization for any combination or series of projects. In addition, no project, if split or shared between municipalities, may receive more than \$4 million in additional subsidization.

All projects in Categories A & B selected as candidates to receive additional subsidization will be identified in a subsequent IUP amendment.

NEW IUP Section 3.7.2 Project Category D

Eligible projects listed in Category D (Hardship) in the Annual CWSRF Project Priority list may, in addition to reduced interest rate financing, receive additional subsidization for up to 75% or \$2 million of eligible project costs necessary to reach the Target Service Charge.

The total amount of additional subsidization available for eligible projects in Project Category D is \$30,000,000. However, no municipality may receive more than \$2 million total in additional subsidization for any combination or series of projects. In addition, no project, if split or shared between municipalities, may receive more than \$2 million in additional subsidization.

All projects in Category D selected as candidates to receive additional subsidization will be identified in a subsequent IUP amendment.

NEW IUP Section 3.7.3 Energy Efficiency Evaluations - Additional Subsidization Hold Back

In order to qualify for the maximum additional subsidization allocation as described above for Categories A, B and D, the municipality will be required to conduct an energy efficiency analysis of the proposed water quality project. Working with our partners at the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA), and potentially the New York State Power Authority (NYPA), financial and technical resources will be provided to fund and undertake such analysis at little or no cost.

If a municipality opts to proceed with the CWSRF financing without conducting an energy efficiency analysis, then the additional subsidization award for that project will be reduced by 20% (i.e., a \$10 million project in Category B qualifies for up to \$4 million in additional subsidization; if the municipality opts to not conduct energy efficiency analysis, the maximum additional subsidization award is reduced to \$3.2 million.)

To receive 100% of the respective additional subsidization allocation, the municipality will be required to successfully undertake one of the following:

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1. Conduct an independent energy efficiency analysis (which can be provided by NYSERDA) that confirms the initial facility plans incorporate sufficient, demonstrable energy efficiency measures;
2. Conduct an independent energy efficiency analysis (which can be provided by NYSERDA) and demonstrate that the facility plans have been updated to incorporate sufficient, demonstrable energy efficiency measures; or
3. Formally request and receive a written waiver from EFC. Under this option, the municipality should demonstrate that the project has little or no opportunity to incorporate energy efficiency improvements.

NEW IUP Section 3.7.4 Project Category C

Eligible projects listed in the Annual CWSRF Project Priority list for Project Category C may receive additional subsidization for projects approved as green infrastructure, water or energy efficiency improvements, or other environmentally innovative activities. The total amount of additional subsidization available for Project Category C is \$30,000,000.

All projects in Category C selected as candidates to receive additional subsidization will be identified in a subsequent IUP amendment.

NEW IUP Section 3.7.5 Project Category G

EFC will offer a new round of grant funding for Category G - GIGP projects for FFY 2010, and expects to call for applications in the summer of 2010. Eligible projects listed in the Annual CWSRF Project Priority list for Project Category G may receive additional subsidization for projects approved as green infrastructure, water or energy efficiency improvements, or other environmentally innovative activities. The total amount of grant available for eligible projects in Project Category G is \$15,000,000.

All projects in Category G selected as candidates to receive additional subsidization will be identified in a subsequent IUP amendment.

IUP Section 5.0 SOURCES AND USES

We have added the revised “5.3 Table B: Estimated Sources of Funds and Financing Potential - Revised” (attached) to show the revised distribution of funds for the CWSRF program. An additional \$15 million in unused resources from the FFY 2009 IUP, \$25 million in capital released from long term investments back to the CWSRF, and approximately \$5 million identified in the 2010 IUP as issued in the fall of 2009 for additional subsidization that is no longer available for that use, is now available for use in the FFY 2010 financing period. The table illustrates that the CWSRF program has approximately \$518,629,678 available in resources for providing subsidized financing during this FFY.

PROJECT PRIORITY LIST

“8.0 Appendix A: Amended Annual CWSRF Project Priority List for CWSRF Financing” (attached) includes lists of projects in Categories A, B, C, D & E that EFC may finance with available CWSRF funds by September 30, 2010. Due to an administrative oversight when publishing the Final IUP Annual List, we have added project C3-5311-01, Dutchess County WWA – Hamlet of Amenia, and C5-5544-01-00, Town of Stillwater, which were inadvertently omitted

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from the final IUP Category A Annual List. Project C1-5153-05-03, Town of North Hempstead, was noted in the final IUP Multi-Year List as being on the Annual List, however, it was not, is also added to the Category B Annual List. Some minor changes in project financing amounts that reflect documented increases or decreases in project cost estimates are also included.

The following projects are added to the Final 2010 IUP Annual List and will only be eligible for market-rate or guarantee financing during FFY 2010:
